VIRTUAL COURSE VIA ZOOM

Become nationally certified as an AFO, receive 1.5 CEU's and a Certificate of Completion and Certification Card. Certification is valid for five years.

The Aquatic Facility Operator (AFO) Course is specifically designed to meet the needs of those working in public and semi-public recreational pool or water park facilities featuring the new AFO Manual, one of the most current publications available on pool operations. The AFO program offers unique discussions on risk management not usually directed towards operational personnel as well as training in proper water chemistry, water chemistry challenges and solutions.

This course is a combination of the AFO online learning course (completed within 2 weeks prior to the one day portion) and a one-day instructor-led in real time Zoom training. At the end of the in-person training day there will be a 50 question open book exam. Upon successful completion of the course and exam, participants will be officially certified by the National Certification Board of the National Recreation & Parks Association.
